Baby Cleaning Procedure

Removing pen marks, clothing dye and staining.

You will need:

Benzac 10 or Oxy10 (an acne remedy available from chemists)

A paint or pastry brush

A large old towel

Apron

Gloves

Scouring Pad

Rubber Gloves

Detergent

Joint Lubricant (from Virtual Parenting) or Valve and O Ring Silicone Lubricant (hardware store)

Take Care:

Benzac 10 and Oxy 10 will remove the dye from clothing so it is advisable to use an apron and old towels or sheets.

Avoid coating the painted areas with Benzac 10 or Oxy10 as it can remove the paint. If this occurs don't panic Virtual Parenting has a repainting service. For Details call 1800 35 35 99

Avoid coating the eyes as Benzac 10 / Oxy10 will blur the surface of the eye. If this does occur the eyes can be polished with Brasso.

It is best not to remove the head of the Realistic Head Support Baby or the RealCare Baby as this may damage the neck and the wiring inside.

Procedure:

1. Remove arms and legs.
 - a. *Tip: For a Standard baby it is possible to remove the head. This will make cleaning the face easier.*
2. Coat the area to be cleaned with a generous coating of Benzac 10/Oxy10 ensuring all stains are covered.
 - a. *Tip: When cleaning limbs coat one side, continue with the procedure then repeat for the other side.*
 - b. *Tip: it is better to coat the whole limb to ensure an even clean with no dirty patches*
 - c. *Tip: For RealCare babies where the head still attached to the body during cleaning and the torso does not require cleaning wrap in a towel or blanket to protect the electronics from the direct sun.*
3. Place in the sun behind glass for 2 or 3 hours depending on the severity of the staining.
 - a. *Tip: An ideal place to do this is on the dashboard of your car as it gets nice and hot.*
4. Repeat the procedure for the other side of the limbs or torso.
5. When the Baby parts have "baked " for a while, wash off the Benac/Oxy10 using a scouring pad and dish washing detergent and warm water.
 - a. *Tip: Wear rubber gloves during this part of the procedure to save your skin.*
 - b. *Tip: A nailbrush is helpful for fingers and toes.*
 - c. *Tip: Cotton buds are useful to clean the ears, nose and mouth.*
6. When the baby parts are all dry inside and out reassemble baby
 - a. *Tip: Joint Lubricant will make it easier to replace limbs and a Standard Head*
7. Wipe the Baby over with a Baby wash Cloth to restore the "baby smell"
